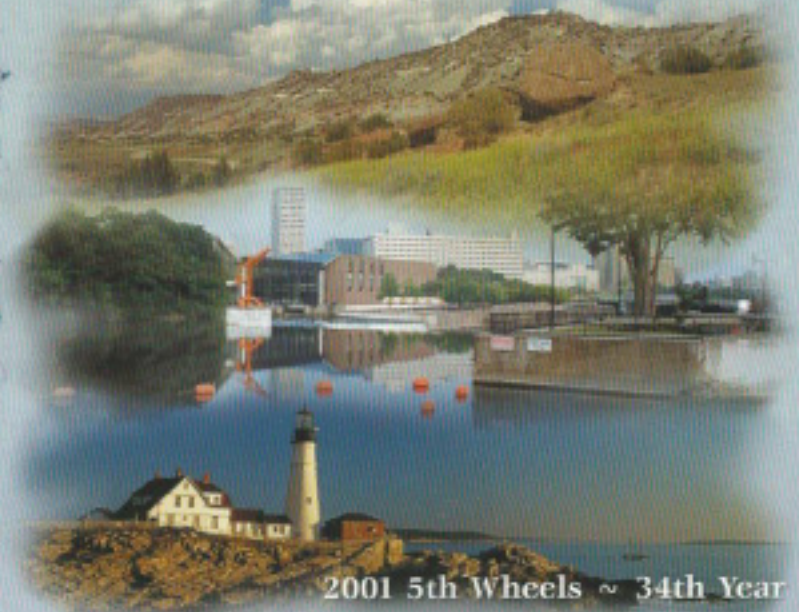

#### Low Profile

Grand's low profile option eliminates stairs between bath and bedroom and creates a ceiling height of 6'7" throughout the unit. It also offers increased height in the bedroom slide-out and enhanced closet space. NOTE: Your truck bed must feature low profile tying to provide necessary truck-to-trailer clearance.

Open, spacious Grand bedroom and bath suites feature lavish decor and luxurious features. Included are a fitted bedspread and dust ruffle that coordinate with swing draperies. Designer day/night shades have a black-out feature for complete privacy. The hinged pedestal bed conceals a large underbed storage compartment. This model has optional shirt closets with drawers and a full mirrored wardrobe. King size beds are available in all Grand floor plans.

Grand sets the standard for beauty with meticulous attention to such details as solid oak drawer slides, trim with flared flanges and tapered corners and feet blocks. The curved, flared edge shell embellishes cabinetry at doors in kitchens and baths.

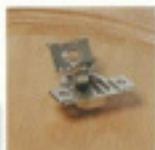

Located in its own private room is a finished washroom with hand-held spray wand for easy cleaning. Other Teton features a classic china cabinet with residential use and open shelving. Step lights add safety in bathroom areas.

White bedrooms combine storage, beauty, and comfort. Amenities include a queen bed with designer spread and matching window treatments, a wet/dry shower with the drawers, a sliding mirror that controls the window, and a handy computer desk with phone jack and modem hookup. In all three positions, additional phone jacks are located in the living area.

Expedition's optional computer desk (residential use) is functional and beautiful. Here, a 27" optional TV rests on a pullout raised TV shelf. Behind the decorative glass doors are a Sony residential AM/FM stereo receiver (equipped with a fine sound system) and a five disk CD changer. The optional computer desk with windows features a pull out work top, computer keyboard tray, file drawers and ample room for computer equipment. All this is built into a space-saving structure. The round dining table comes with four chairs and an 18" leaf - the coffee table is optional.

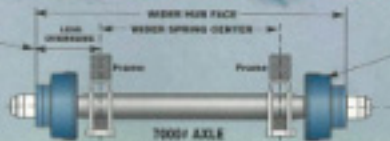

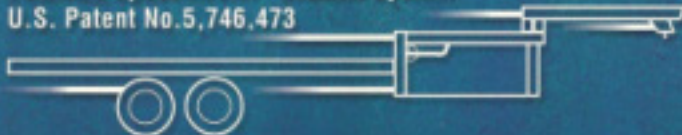

## Wood Versus Aluminum... Which is Better?

The wood versus aluminum argument is almost as old as the RV industry. Which type of framing is best depends entirely on how you use your RV. At Teton Homes, we specialize in luxury fifth wheels designed with the full-time RVer in mind. Let us examine some of the advantages of wood framed structures.

### TEMPERATURE CONTROL

In full-time RVing, temperatures can vary greatly from extreme hot to extreme cold. Wood has insulative properties that help maintain a constant and comfortable interior temperature, no matter what the weather. Aluminum conducts and transfers heat and cold from outside to inside, making heating and cooling systems work harder with less efficiency.

### CONDENSATION

Rapid temperature changes and extreme weather whose interior and exterior temperatures vary greatly cause condensation in aluminum framing. Because wood maintains temperature far better than aluminum, there is no condensation with wood framing.

### WEIGHT

Overall weight is important. In small RVs, aluminum framing is lighter than wood. Large, complex fifth wheels require intensive framing and support to maintain overall integrity. That's why, in units over 32 feet in length, wood and aluminum framing weigh virtually the same.

### DRY ROT

Early manufacturing methods required many seams in RV exteriors, allowing water to get into framing and cause dry rot. Today's construction methods, including lamination, smooth siding and single piece impermeable vinyl roofs virtually eliminate the possibility of water entering wood framing and have made dry rot obsolete.

### STRUCTURAL FATIGUE

Extended road travel can cause fatigue of metal structure, particularly exterior walls. When combined with today's wall vacuum bonding techniques, wood and metal framing offer equal overall strength. However, metal framing can develop costly and dangerous stress cracks at welds and can transfer stress from one joint to another causing failure. This cannot happen with wood framing.

### INSULATION

All RVs are framed with wood, aluminum or steel and insulated with either block foam or blanket fiberglass. Wood framing enhances insulation properties because it does not transfer temperatures like metal does.

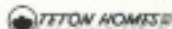
